NOTIFICATION

No. 3626-UD/O/M/HID/41-3/2011, Dated, Kolkata, 09.09.2016 — In exercise of the powers conferred by section 159 read with section 126, section 127 & section 128 of The New Town Kolkata Development Authority Act, 2007 (West Bengal Act XXX of 2007) (hereinafter referred to as the said Act), the Governor is hereby pleased to make, after previous publication as required under sub-section (1) of section 159 of the said Act, the following rules namely : —

Rules

Chapter I

1. **Short title, application and commencement:**— (1) These rules may be called The New Town Kolkata Municipal Solid Waste (imposition of fine) Rules, 2016.
(2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the *Official Gazette*.
2. **Definitions:** In these rules, unless the context otherwise requires —
 - (a) ‘Municipal Solid Waste’ includes commercial and residential wastes generated in a municipal or notified areas in either solid or semi-solid form excluding industrial hazardous wastes but including treated bio-medical wastes [as defined in rule 3(xv) of the Municipal Solid Wastes (Management and Handling) Rules, 2000 made by Government of India under section 3, 6 and 25 of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 (29 of 1986)].
 - (b) ‘Person’ means any individual, group of persons, organisation, institution.
3. **Disposal of Municipal Solid Waste:** It shall be the responsibility of any person to dispose of properly Municipal Solid Waste generated by him. The waste shall be disposed of only in community bins or to the collection vehicles deployed by New Town Kolkata Development Authority for collection of Municipal Solid Waste from each premises.

4. **Prohibition in littering of Municipal Solid Waste:** No person shall deposit or cause to deposit or throw upon any Municipal Solid Waste at any public place, public street, public footpath, public drain, bank of public drain, in sewerage pipeline and in any water course or bank of water course or at vacant plot.
5. **Levy & Collection of Fine:** New Town Kolkata Development Authority (NKDA) shall impose a fine of Rs. 100.00 (rupees one hundred only) for each incidence of littering of Municipal Solid Waste from the concerned person. In case of failure to pay the fine within the stipulated time as may be notified by New Town Kolkata Development Authority, additional fine @ Rs.10 (rupees ten) only per day of delay shall be imposed subject to maximum Rs.500.00 (rupees five hundred) only.
